The Pride of Port St. Lucie Jaguar Marching Band earned <u>Straight</u> <u>Superiors</u> at Crown Jewel Festival!

On October 16th - the Jaguar band competed amongst the finest of high school marching bands in Florida performing their 2010 Swing Time Half-time show at the 29th annual Crown Jewel Marching Band Festival. PSL earned straight superiors in all categories of the preliminary competition in the Emerald Division. The Citrus Bowl Stadium at Vero Beach High School came alive with hundreds of spectators to see and hear the talented young musicians perform their half-time shows.

Other high schools that competed in this year's festival included: Ruby Division, Okeechobee (Best Music, Best General Effect, Best Auxiliary, Best Percussion and Grand Champion trophies.) Palm Beach Gardens earned Best Marching and first runner-up; South Fork second runner-up. Emerald Division, Jensen Beach gained Best Music, Best General Effect, Best Marching, Best Percussion and Grand Champion titles this year. Clearwater received first runner-up, and Port St. Lucie was named second runner-up! From the Diamond Division, Sebastian River received Best Music, Best General Effect, Best Auxiliary and Grand Champion trophies. J. P. Taravella from Coral Springs earned Best Percussion and first runner-up; second runner-up going to Melbourne.

The Crown Jewel Band Festival is sponsored by the Vero Beach HS Band and the Fighting Indians Band Boosters which was formed 29 years ago and is one of the oldest of its kind. This event provides invaluable constructive evaluation with placement, ratings, comments and education from leading clinicians in the industry. Thank you to all the Jaguar fans who came out to support the band.
