VERY IMPORTANT NEWS IN THE SENATE ON SENATE BILL 6

According to news reports, Gov. Crist will take a week to decide whether to sign or veto Senate Bill 6. Your action is needed ASAP to contact Gov. Crist's office and ask for his veto of this bill. Get informed on this very important bill. This would be the time to personally contact Gov. Crist office to ask him to veto Senate Bill 6. His email is Charlie.Crist@myflorida.com. The phone number for the Exec. Office of the governor is 850-488-7146 (8am to 5 pm EDT.) It may also be of interest to you to know that 11 Republicans broke ranks with their leadership on this bill-an act that is very rare—and voted against State Bill 6. They are: Rep. Faye Culp, Tampa; Rep. Ed Homan, Tampa; Rep Marcelo Llorente, Miami; Rep Peter Nehr, Tarpon Springs; Rep. Pat Patterson, Deland; Rep. Julio Robaina, Miami; Rep Ron Schultz, Homosassa; Rep. Charles Van Sant, Palatka; Rep. Mike Weinstein, Jacksonville; Rep. Juan Zapata, Miami. All of the Democratic members of the state House of Representatives voted against the bill.
